Then college library Inflibnet plays a vital role to promote communication between researchers and academics. Every year renewal subscription and teaches login for freshers. The members can access at any time and any place. Lot of E-resources are available like e-sodhsindhu to facilitate academic communication among experts. N-List covers all the subject areas.

During working hours, facilities available include borrowing/returning/ renewal of books, reprographic services, press clippings, reference services, Wi-Fi facility, etc.,. It is an automatic system that reduces the work burden of the librarians through a single click.

The librarian and the library assistant often keep abreast with the latest changes to support the curriculum of various changes in syllabus. Books are open shelved according to their Classification number There are 104 computers available for the students and staff members to access to electronic resources to the core for the utilization. CCTV surveillance cameras were fixed for monitoring students' performance inside the library. It has excellent ICT infrastructure with adequate bandwidth for fast and seamless access to Internet.
